

# SOUTHWOOD LAKE WATER SKI CLUB

## RULES

### 1. *Financial*

Financial requirements for year one:

- ⊖ Initiation Fee: \$6,000
- ⊖ Membership \$200
- ⊖ Usage Fee \$15 member/ride (6 slalom passes, 10 min. tricks)  
\$30 non member/ride

Thank you for ensuring the long term viability of our club by recording all rides.

### 2. *Membership*

Membership and use of the site and facilities is a privilege. The member may withdraw, or the membership may be revoked, at any time, for any reason. The initiation fee paid will be refunded within sixty (60) days, less any outstanding charges due.

### 3. *Conduct*

The lake was created by the development of a residential community. The facility is located within a residential community. The conduct of club members must respect the objective of responsible lake use and peaceful harmonious operation within the community.

Water skiing is a competitive sport; however, emotions must be kept under control. Profanity, excessive noise, or rude behaviour will not be tolerated. No littering is permitted. The site must be kept clean. The equipment must be kept in a neat and tidy fashion.

### 4. *Gas*

Please record and submit gas purchases. Gas purchase credits will be calculated against ride usage fees or reimbursed by the club.

### 5. *Repairs, Maintenance, Storage*

Damage to the boat or propeller by use will be paid for by the operator responsible. Mechanical breakdowns will be paid for by the club.

### 6. *Volunteer work*

Volunteer work, installation, and maintenance upkeep of the facilities must be shared equitably by the members.

### 7. *Tournament*

The club will participate in the Canada's Capital Slalom Challenge (CCSC) weekend. Members are encouraged to help out with the tournament which helps fund club activities and set-up of the site.

### 8. *Ski school*

The club will endeavour to host an annual ski school.

### 9. *Drivers*

Drivers must be approved by the club president and must have a Water Ski and Wakeboard Canada (WSWC) or similar drivers rating, a provincial boating license, and pass a boating test for site conditions. No guest drivers are permitted without approval of the club president.
